

Construction Alert: Week of November 4, 2024

Traffic signals will be OFF at the intersection of Van Buren Boulevard and Rutile Street on Wednesday, Nov 6. | 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.



Stop signs will be in place and all motorists must stop at the intersection.

Crews will be completing electrical work on traffic and train signals in the area. Please allow extra travel time and reduce speed in the area.

PROJECT UPDATE

- Crews will be working throughout the project area during the week of November 4. No traffic impacts are expected, please travel with caution through the project area.
- **Tuesday, Nov. 5 |** Work is planned near the train tracks at Rutile street and Van Buren Blvd.
- **Thursday, Nov. 7 |** Motorists can expect construction work on the south side of Jurupa Road at Pedley Road.







Railroad track work is planned throughout the week in the project area, and Bly Channel drainage work continues near the UPRR track.
