

The Jurupa Road Grade Separation project will build an underpass under Van Buren Road and the Union Pacific Railroad, separating train traffic from vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists.

PROJECT BENEFITS

- Improved safety and traffic circulation
- Improved air quality
- Noise reduction

Safety and traffic circulation

The new grade separation underpass will eliminate the at-grade railroad crossing at Jurupa Road and create a safe and direct east/west route through the area with no stops required for the 21-daily UPRR trains. This will greatly improve safety and traffic circulation for emergency services, residents, businesses, and visitors in one of Jurupa Valley's most heavily-travelled residential and commerce corridors. The new multi-use path also provides a separated and safe route for pedestrians and cyclists.

Air quality

The new Jurupa Road underpass and access roads onto Van Buren Boulevard will greatly reduce idling traffic waiting for trains and traffic signals, thus reducing vehicle emissions and improving air quality.

Noise reduction

The new grade separation eliminates the at grade crossing at Jurupa Road and provides increased safety so trains will no longer be required to blow whistles, reducing noise in the area. Additionally, the new access roads will be constructed using Rubberized Hot Mix Asphalt (RHMA) which reduces road noise from vehicle tires.

Construction

Construction started in late 2021 and will continue through Winter 2026. Jurupa Road will be closed at Van Buren Boulevard for the duration of the project. The closure is necessary to construct the new Van Buren Blvd. northbound and southbound bridges, the UPRR bridge, and to lower Jurupa Road under the bridges.



WHAT TO EXPECT

- Motorists can expect traffic delays in the area, lane closures and traffic control.
- Residents and business owners in the area may experience typical noise associated with construction projects.
